## Rare and Intresting Cases of Bone & Soft Tissue Neoplasms with Their Clinico-Pathological and Radiological Features

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Among the wide array of human neoplasms, tumor of bone and soft tissue are not very common and account for only less than 1 percent of all neoplasms.Central Institute Of Orthopaedics is a referral centre for musculoskeletal pathology where a large amount of bone and soft tissue tumours are seen.We are presenting eight rare variants of bone & soft tissue sarcomas with their clinico-pathological and radiological features, reported in the department of orthopaedics, VMMC & SJH. - 1. Low grade fibromyxoid sarcoma
- 2. Soft tissue sarcoma
